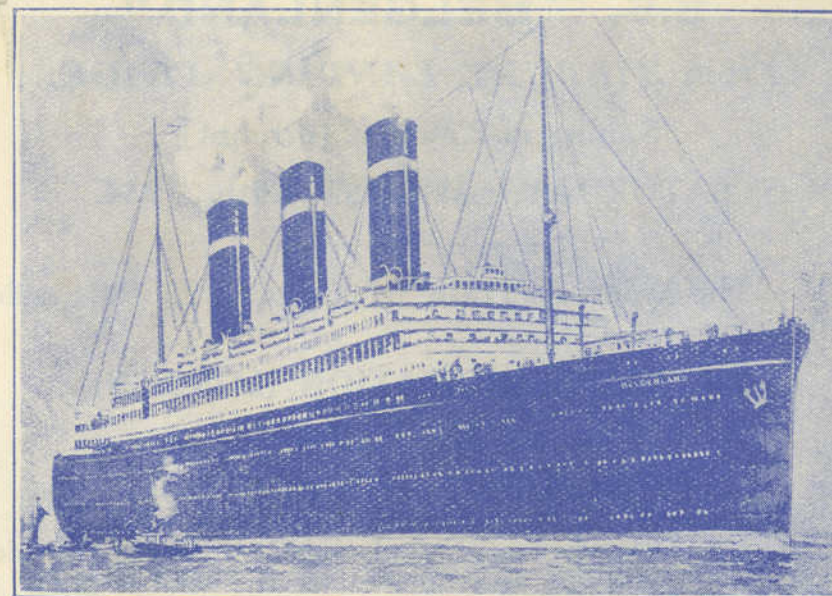

EMBARKATION ARRANGEMENTS.

S.S. "BELGENLAND"

From TILBURY LANDING STAGE,

Sailing at 2.30 p.m. [prompt],

SATURDAY, AUGUST 25th, 1934.

The **Special Train** to connect with this sailing will leave

ST. PANCRAS STATION (LONDON),

at 12.15 P.M.

for TILBURY LANDING STAGE.

The special train is the only means of transit by which the Red Star Line can guarantee the embarkation of passengers. Passengers proceeding to Tilbury Landing Stage by road or other trains should allow sufficient time to cover possible delays. Owing to the number of steamers using the Landing Stage on this date, the "Belgenland" will not be in a position to embark passengers prior to 1.15 p.m.

Embarkation will take place from **1.15 p.m. to 2.00 p.m.**

Steamer tickets must be produced for inspection at the gangway before embarkation.

Passengers are reminded that the Special Train will be leaving St. Pancras during the holiday rush period and are advised to allow themselves ample time at the station.

MOTOR CARS.—Special arrangements have been made for the garaging of passengers' automobiles at Tilbury during the Cruise, and particulars can be had on application. Garage reservation should be made in advance.

BALANCES of passage money are due for payment on or before the 11th August, 1934, and Steamer Tickets should accompany remittance.

PASSPORTS will be required by all passengers on this Cruise. No visas will be required by British passengers, but their passports must bear endorsement for travel to Turkey.

RAILWAY TICKETS AT REDUCED RATES.

Tickets for the Special Train can be obtained at St. Pancras Station on sailing day, or in advance from the Red Star Line, 38, Leadenhall Street, London, E.C. 3.

First Class.....Single 4s. 0d. Return (Summer Ticket) 5s. 6d.

Third Class.....Single 2s. 5d. Return (Summer Ticket) 3s. 3d.

The **Return** half will be available by the **Special Train** which will convey passengers from **Tilbury** to St. Pancras at the termination of the Cruise.

Return rail tickets (Summer) from provincial stations either first or third class can be obtained at the rate of a single fare and one-third for the double journey, available for return within one month of issue.

BAGGAGE.

All Baggage can be taken by the Special Train and will be transferred direct from the Special Train to the Steamer.

BAGGAGE IN ADVANCE.—Baggage may be sent in advance if desired and should be addressed as follows :—

Advance baggage should arrive at Tilbury at least one day before sailing. The Red Star Line undertakes to have such baggage placed in the passenger's cabin before the arrival of the Special Train.

The Company's Liability for Baggage is strictly limited, but passengers can protect themselves by insurance which may be effected at any of the Company's Offices or Agencies.

LABELS.—All Baggage must be labelled with Red Star Line labels before passengers take train for Tilbury.

It is recommended that trunks be limited in size to 3 feet by 2 feet by 14 inches high.
