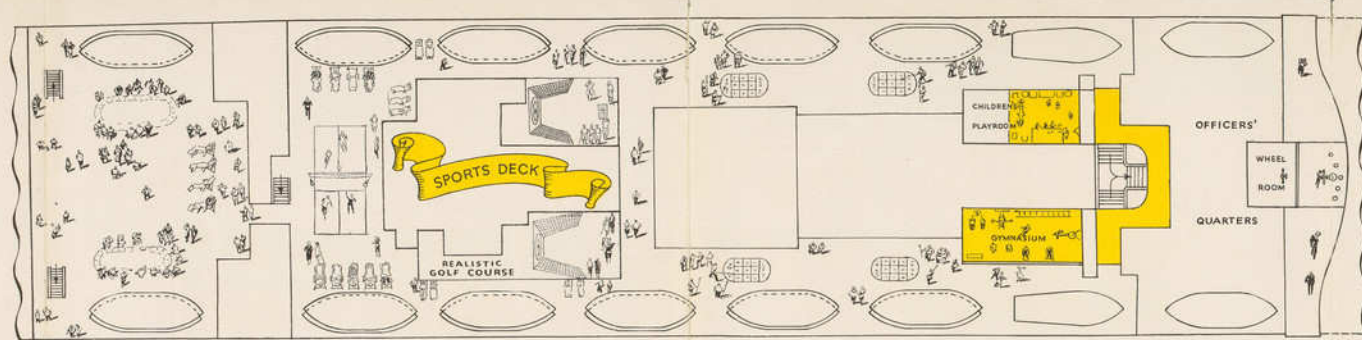

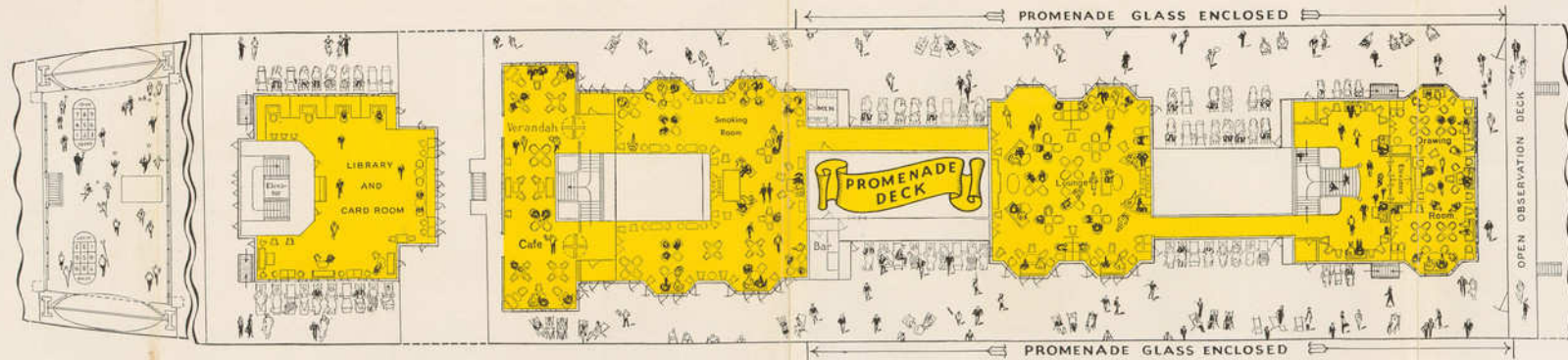
SMALL SECTION OF "LIDO DECK"



NO STEPPING OVER CHAIRS OR LEGS ON THIS BROAD PROMENADE DECK



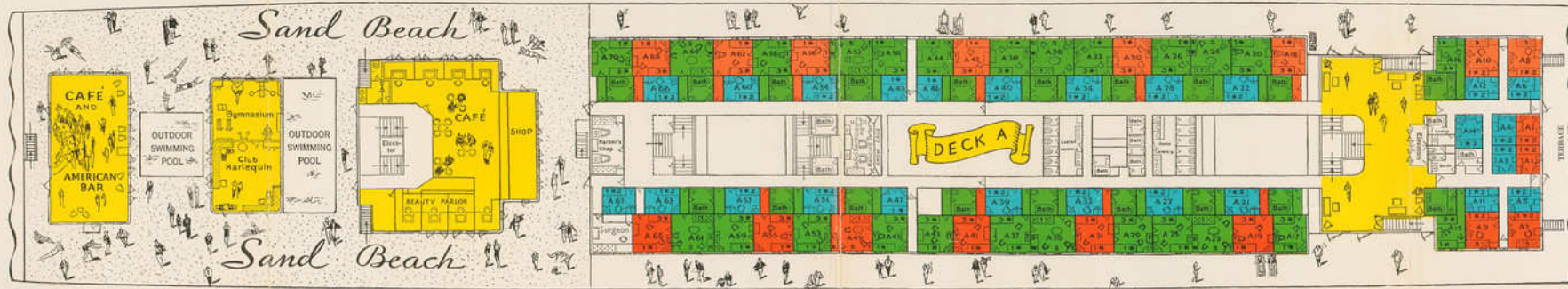

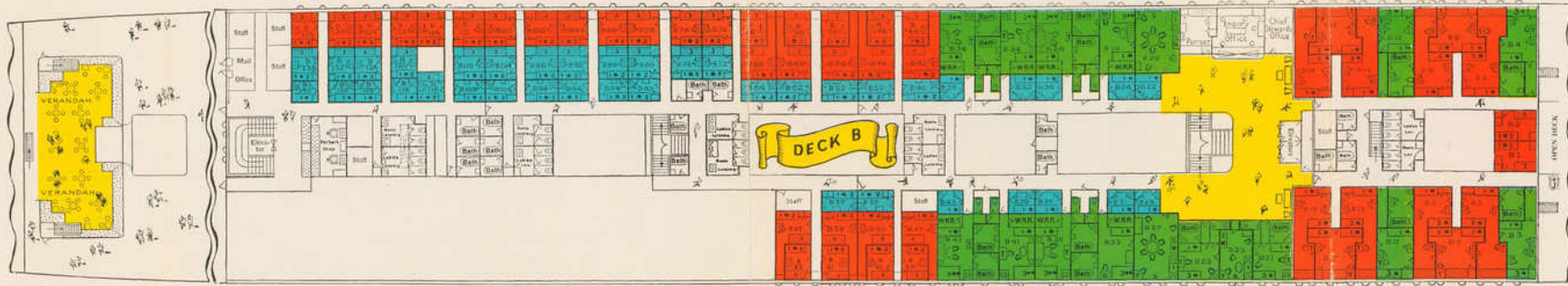

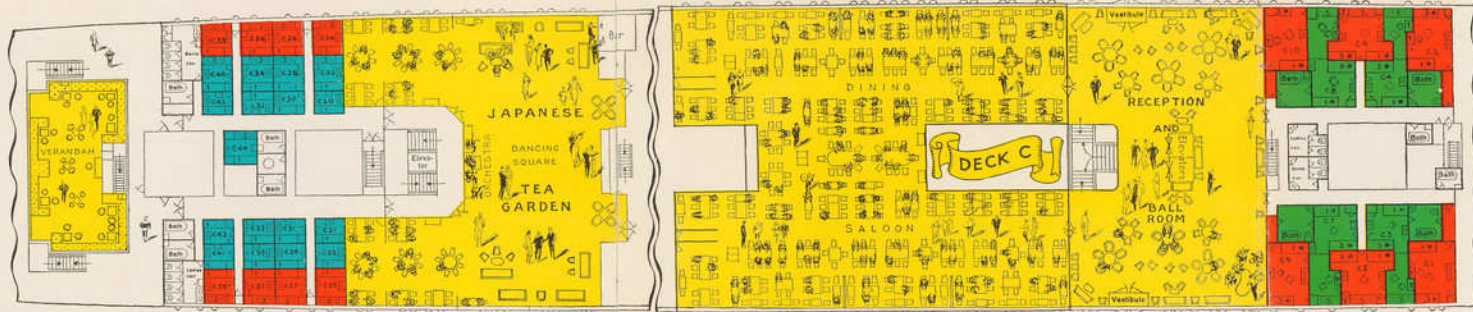

INDOOR SWIMMING POOL AND TURKISH BATH ON DECK F

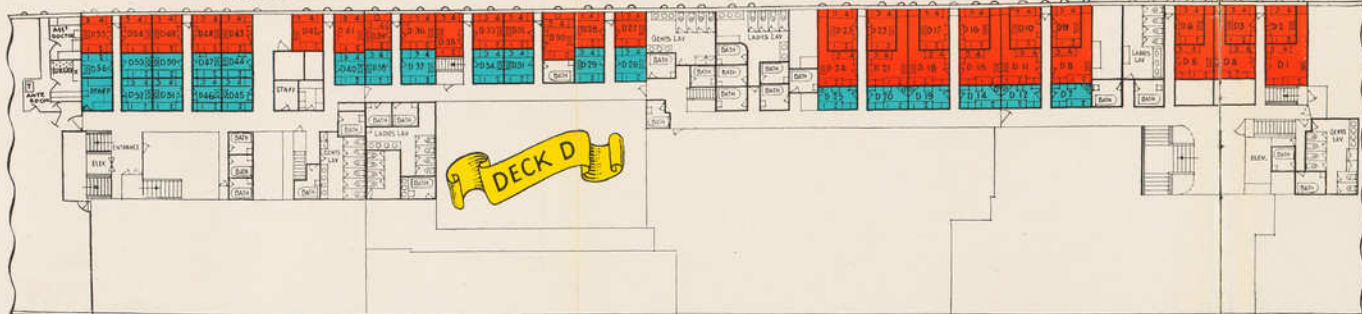


OUTSIDE DOUBLE ROOM "C8" AND SIMILAR

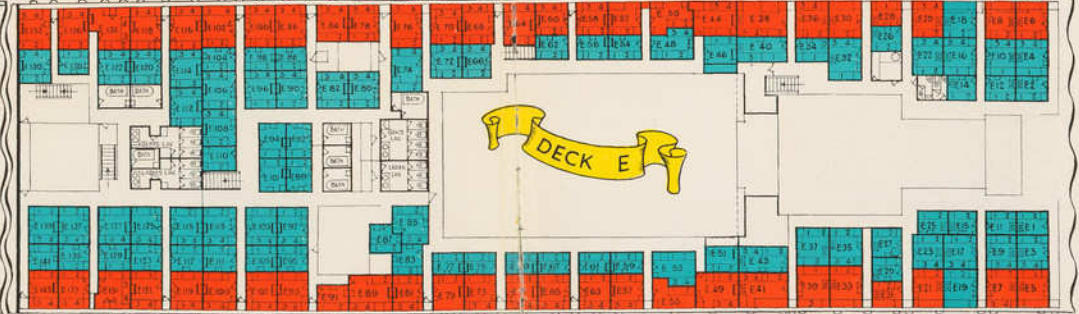


TYPE OF OUTSIDE STATEROOM FOR TWO PERSONS—LIKE C8, D43, ETC.
